

EDIS International Conference of Emerging Diplomatic Studies

The Centro Interateneo Notariorum Itinera (CSINI) and the Research Project of Relevant National Interest (PRIN) 2020 «Per (ri)scrivere la storia del Mezzogiorno medievale. Forme testuali del potere (secoli XIV-XV)» are organising the second edition of EDIS, Emerging Diplomatic Studies, on **October 30th 31st 2024** in Bari (with simultaneous virtual participation). The conference is dedicated to young scholars of Diplomatics. Held for the first time in 2022, it aims to create a venue for the dissemination of research-in-progress in Diplomatics, and to encourage personal and scholarly interactions between established scholars and young researchers from Italy and abroad, belonging to different scholarly traditions and operating in different contexts, not least the digital one.

The proposals are sought from PhD candidates and early-career researchers under **35 years old** and with a PhD earned no more than **5 years** before the application. Proposals must relate to the **diplomatic study** of medieval documentary sources. Specifically, the second meeting of EDIS welcomes proposals that investigate the forms and practices of office documentation, produced by public and private administrations and by external subjects connected to them, without chronological or geographic constraints. This theme aligns with one of the PRIN's themes, which involves the study of documentary typologies produced by the public officials of the Kingdom of Naples in the 14th & 15th century using the inventory of the surviving documentation preserved at the Archivio di Stato di Napoli.

Proposals should be sent to convegno.edis@gmail.com no later than **January 31st 2024**. Each proposal should contain the author's name, email and affiliation (if applicable), as well as a short *curriculum vitae* (max. 500 characters), the paper's title and abstract (max. 1,000 characters). The proposals selected by the Scientific Advisory Board will be announced by **February 29, 2024** by e-mail. Any accepted paper must be presented in a 20-minute presentation in one of the following languages: Italian, English, Spanish or French. Papers submitted for publication will be evaluated by the Scientific Advisory Board and two blind peer-reviewers and, if eligible, they may be published in an open-access issue in the CSINI *Varia* series.

Thanks to the contribution of the Italian Associazione Italiana Paleografi e Diplomatisti (AIPD), one prize in the amount of € 500 and two prizes in the amount of € 250 will be awarded to the best presentations selected by the Scientific-Organising Board. The organisers will provide conference speakers with dinner and overnight accommodations on October 30, 2024, and lunch on October 31, 2024. Travel expenses will be covered by the individual speakers.
